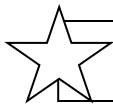

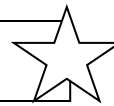

April 15, 2017

Deadline to submit the FAFSA to be considered for the WV Higher Education Grant

June 3, 2017: SAT

Last date to take the SAT to establish scholarship eligibility (reasoning test only). Scores will not be accepted for any SAT taken after June 3, 2017.

June 10, 2017: ACT

Last date to take the ACT (national test only) to establish scholarship eligibility. Scores will not be accepted for any ACT taken after June 10, 2017.
