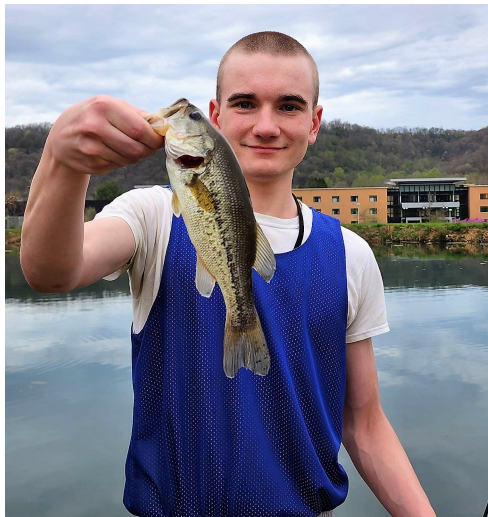
Children of any ages are to be counted as part of the six (6) guests.
